## MIRANDA LICHTENSTEIN

Haunting color photographs of deserted construction sites and vacant corporate locales, all with an uneasy anonymity. They document the planned community of Cyberjaya, Malaysia's failed attempt to cultivate its own Silicon Valley outside Kuala Lumpur. (The show could double as a photo-essay on state-sponsored hubris.) In "Enterprise Zone," a bright-yellow backhoe rises dramatically above a yawning chasm in the ground stripped clean of vegetation while city lights glitter with incongruous glamour in the distance.
